You'll learn how to conduct the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) and Emergency First Response Secondary Care (first aid) courses. You'll also learn to conduct the recommended Automated External Defibrillator (AED), and conscious choking management skills.

### How long will it take?

The Emergency First Response Instructor Course takes approximately eight hours.
