



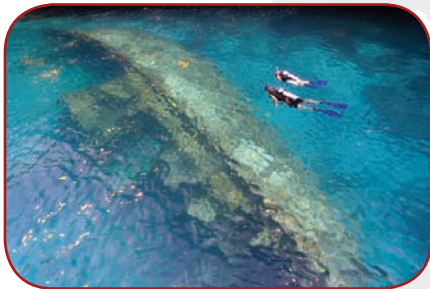
CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER SPECIALTY INSTRUCTOR COURSE

- Teach PADI Specialty courses to divers in a variety of areas from wreck diving to underwater videography.

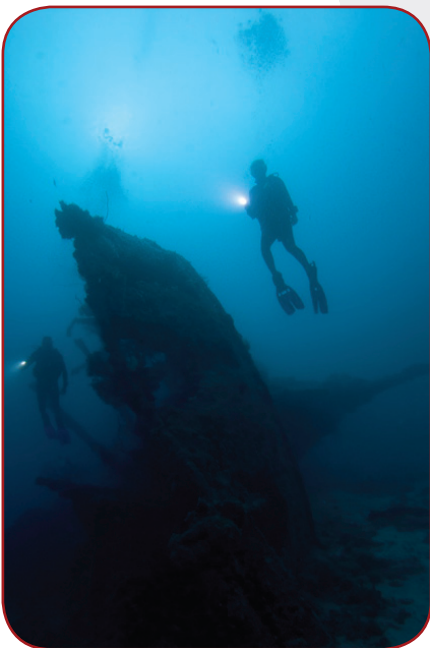


What qualifications will I need to start?
